Dunn County Fair Farm Truck & Tractor Pull Rules

- Farm stock means tractors right out of the field.
- Minors must be accompanied by a parent or a Guardian.
- All classes are open to all counties.
- Two wheel drive tractors only in all classes.
- Grace weight will be 200 lbs in all classes.
- Entries must draw for position in each class.
- Tractors may hook once per class.
- No dual wheels allowed.
- No aluminum rims, no cut tires.
- No alcohol as a fuel in any class.
- Tractor and driver must weigh in before each class begins at our designated scale on the grounds.
- Tractor will be allowed two hooks and operator should know their tractor's weight and proper classes to pull in before registering.
- If the sled is not set correctly, the Puller may pull again at the end of the class.
- Loss of weight at any part of the tractor during the pull will be grounds for disqualification.
- No weights hanging directly above the drawbar. Must have a 12" opening for hooking up to the sled.
- No weight frame or weight can be extended 24" beyond front of the tractor.
- Tractors will be disqualified if the front wheels are 24" or more above the ground from start to finish.
- Drawbar height maximum will be 20" to the top of the clevis.
- All pullers must furnish a 3" clevis fastened to the drawbar with ¾" or larger bolt and nut or safety pin.
- Any tractor with a blower (internal or external) not naturally aspirated, will pull in the Turbo Class.
- Tractor may have one turbo only.
- Tractor must have factory fuel system for make and model of that tractor.
- All pullers must start with a tight chain and driver will be allowed two attempts (consecutive) to adjust speed in the first 100 feet of the pull.
- All drivers must remain seated and must drive in a safe manner.
- If track allows, a pull may be measured beyond 300 feet (floating finish).
- In a pull-off, puller is allowed one attempt to start the sled and make their pull.
- When puller is pulling and before he or she starts to make their pull, they must have the green flag.
- Any puller starting on the red flag will be disqualified.
- In case of disqualification, the committee's decisions are final.
- All drivers pull at their own risk.
- Only the puller is allowed on the tractor just before, during and right after the pull is completed.
- A 5mph speed limit is to be maintained in the pit area.
- Tractors must have hoods, grills, starters, batteries, and a seat.
- Tractors must have working PTO and hydraulics.
- 7500# and up must have tire height metal fenders.
- Speed limit for Farm Stock (non-turbo) classes: 5500# & up = 5 mph; all other classes 7 mph.
- No alcohol is allowed in the track/pit area. You will be asked to leave and/or escorted out of the area by reserve officers and ineligible to participate in next year's pull.
