

Dunn County Fair Youth Overnight Barn Access Application

Must be completed and turned into Fair Office by July 15

Requirements for youth requesting to stay overnight in the animal barns at the Dunn County Fair:

- Must exhibit an animal(s) at the fair and the animal(s) requires overnight care from the exhibitor
- Must have completed 8th grade (youth that have not completed at least 8th grade may stay on the fairgrounds only if a parent/guardian stays with them)
- Must complete and attach this form to their entry form
- Must sign-up daily in the fair office prior to 9:00 pm if planning to stay that night
- Must wear the arm band received at the time of sign-up between the hours of 12:00 midnight to 6:00 am; armbands will be changed daily
- Must behave appropriately – overnight access may be revoked at any time by the Fair Board or Security Officers
- Must behave in accordance with applicable federal, state and local laws

Some examples of inappropriate behaviors are described below. Youth using inappropriate behavior may be asked to leave the fairgrounds and/or be subject to disciplinary action by the Fair Board.

- Have in their possession or use illegal drugs, alcoholic beverages or tobacco products
- Theft, misuse, or abuse of public or personal property
- Sexual misconduct
- Possession of weapons, firearms, or fireworks
- Disturbing the peace
- Unauthorized use of vehicles
- Use of offensive language

In addition, youth will be held financially liable and responsible for any damage they cause to public or personal property. Youth need to follow the directions given by Dunn County Fair Board and/or their representatives and law officials. Security officials will ask any youth in the barn not wearing an overnight wristband after 12:00 midnight to leave the premises.

The Dunn County Fair reserves the right to amend and/or revise this application and notify exhibitors of any changes prior to or during the event.

I have read and understand the Dunn County Fair overnight barn access guidelines. I agree not to hold the Dunn County Fair, Dunn County Extension Office, Dunn County 4-H Program, Dunn County FFA Programs, other youth organizations, or Dunn County liable for any personal injury or accident while staying overnight at the Dunn County Fair. I agree to be bound by the terms outlined in the Dunn County Fair Overnight Barn Access Application.
