



Market Goat Requirements and Tips

December – Market class animal must be born December 15th of previous year or later.

- January** – It's a good idea to start attending feeding workshops and fitting clinics
 - Feeding and fitting workshop are often held during late winter or early spring.
 - There will be a list of preselected workshops/sessions you will be able to attend.
- February** – If you don't have your market animal selected yet, get planning so you know where you are going to acquire your market animal.
- March/April-Select and/or purchase animal**
 - Market class animals must have been born on or after December 15th of the previous year.
 - There are great resources on the internet that you can use to help you select a market goat.
- April- Dunn County Goat Project Entry Meeting & Weigh in**
 - The Dunn County Goat Weigh-In will be held April 4, 2022 from 8:30AM – 10AM.
 - The animal's weight will depend on when it was born, the closer to December 15th it was born the more it is likely to weigh. There is no maximum weight; however, suggested maximum weight at weigh-in is 50 lbs.
- April – Begin training the animal for showing**
 - It is important to be consistent in how you work with the animal.
 - The more time that you spend with your animal, the more relaxed both of you will be in the show ring! The sooner you start training your goat the better.
 - Animals that cannot be controlled by the exhibitor may be removed from the show/fair by the superintendent.
- May** – May 1st Breeding stock for the fair MUST be under your care
- May – YQCA turned in see General MAP Rules for date and location**

DUNN COUNTY FAIR (WEDNESDAY, JULY 25th – SUNDAY, JULY 31st)

- Check-in** – All market animals must be penned and cleaned by the end of entry time (one hour before weigh-in).
- Wednesday 1:00 PM – Weigh In/Carcass Scanning** (dependent on technician availability)
- Wednesday Hang Project Poster with expense information filled out**
- Thursday 9:00 AM – Goat Show and Carcass Scan after the show**
- Notify Superintendent which animal you will be selling (See General MAP Rules for time)**
- Saturday 5:00 PM – Sale starts and Buyer's dinner begins at 4:00 PM.** There will be arena setup before the sale/buyers dinner that members are expected to help with, there isn't a set time but you will be notified so you know when to be there to help.
- Update Project Poster with buyer and sale information (See General MAP Rules for time)**
- September – Attend the Required Carcass Clinic (See General MAP Rules for date and time)**
